COQUE MIRROR – Hypnotic Mirror with an Edge Design Alain Gilles for MINIFORMS (IT)

The "Coque" mirror is a combination of two unexpected materials: ceramic and mirrored glass. The whole idea was to create a mirror with a somewhat hypnotic effect, but also to give a real body to the mirror thanks to what can be seen as a modern ceramic frame.

The mirror has an hypnotic effect thanks to its round shape, deep depth, but also above all because the mirror seems to be floating in the ceramic hallow that surrounds it. This is further reinforced by a ceramic shell that is treated mate on the outside and glossy on the inside.

In this case the whole mirror really as a body, contrarily to most modern mirrors that would usually feel cold and flat. Since the edge of the ceramic slightly comes over the inner part the two finishes are always visible at the same time.

As for the name of the mirror, Coque, it refers its surrounding shell since it means shell in French and thus highlights its very recognizable ceramic frame.
