Elephant Footprint Seats

NOT COMPROMISED commissioned an experimental outdoor seating collection to the Thai architect Boonserm Premthada, potentially something complementary with his buildings. A limited edition of 40 were executed to start with.

For the debut during Milan Design Week 2024, we prepared a few prototype seats for presentation, and we are going to show the process of making and some alternatives.

NOT COMPROMISED developed a direct collaborative scheme to establish an understandable attitude to the creation of a 'manifesto'. A statement outlining what our show initiatives stand for and how we plan to effect change. Pièces uniques, mirabilia in limited editions, in which experimentation* becomes the true protagonist. Somehow funny statements of collectible items with a *pedigree*.

Each seat has been created with the dung of a single elephant, documented by his ID card!

* Boonserm Premthada is testing several elephant body prints on the same essential form and created an elephant dung mix with fish/shell/crab material to add strength and make it more lightweight. He then infuses the dung with minerals, natural pigments, to obtain a stripe effect of color variation.
