The term comes from the Latin cultellus. Usually it consists of a blade at a tip with one or more sharp edges fixed to a handle or switchblade. This is the vocation of Scarperia who since 1400 is dedicated to the artisan production of cutting tools for the Florentine Republic: careful search of quality raw materials, rigorously in the processing stages and a focus on innovation."


