

# Product explanation

This handmade furniture line is a combination of old industrial Die-cut shapes used in the cardboard industry and the Japanese philosophy and art form Kintsugi.

These die-cut shapes are only used in the fabrication of small series of cardboard cut-outs. After they fulfilled their purpose they are stacked away to eventually be discarded.

Basing myself on the Kintsugi philosophy, I was able to invent a process to give these panels a second life.

Each panel has a unique pattern, which represents the cut-out shape and technical features used in the industrial process.

Using a filler to highlight these patterns in combination with a dark varnish and minimalistic frame work these panels are no longer industrial waste but a unique series of lounge tables.
