KIM presents her "Leisure" series, launched by her virtual association IASLD (International Association of Social Leisure Development) in collaboration with STEAD's unique "Matrjoska" nesting chair project for the brand *La Chaise Gigogne*, for which she has devised a knitted cushion cover.

DIY knitting patterns may be supplied with any 3-in-1 chairs purchased, so that each set potentially becomes a unique work of art, fashioned indeed by the manual skills of the sitter. End game: greater satisfaction for all players.
